Alfred O. Peter, of Horsham, died on Friday, November 26, 2010, at his home surrounded by his loving family. He was 87.

He was the loving husband of Martha (Dettling) Peter, with whom he had

shared 58 years of marriage.

Born in Homersdorf, Germany, he was the son of the late Albert O. and Anna (Klenk) Peter.

Alfred was drafted in Germany where he served during WWII. He survived for 5 years as a prisoner of war in France until in 1949 when he earned his freedom and came to the United States.

He received his associate's degree from Penn State University in 1964.

Alfred was a mechanical engineer for FMC, formerly Link-Belt of Chalfont for 28 years. He traveled all over the world installing and troubleshooting systems and was responsible for several patents. He retired from FMC in 1992.

He is survived in addition to his wife; by his daughter Helga Frieman and her husband David, two grandchildren, Peter and Melissa Hollerbach and two sisters, Trude Vorberg and Suse Dauth. He was pre-deceased by his son Kurt.
